

Major changes to Tooley Street from 30 April

Work on the new London Bridge station entrances on Tooley Street starts on 30 April 2016 as work to rebuild London Bridge station continues as part of the Thameslink Programme. As the work moves across to the other side of the station, access to the work site is required from Tooley Street. To do this, changes need to be made to the road.

May Day Bank Holiday weekend, 30 April – 3 May 2016

From the 0100 Saturday 30 April through to 0600 Tuesday 3 May Tooley Street closes to traffic from Borough High Street to Bermondsey Street. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the weekend. Controlled entry will also be maintained for deliveries and residents via Borough High Street only.

Tuesday, 3 May 2016 until 2018

Road users

Tooley Street closes to eastbound traffic from Borough High Street to Bermondsey Street. Follow the diversion route via Borough High Street, Great Dover Street and Tower Bridge Road. Please allow more time for your journey, especially during the peak hours of 07:00 – 10:00 and 16:00 – 19:00 on weekdays.

Pedestrians

From Tuesday 3 May the footpath on the station side of the road closes to pedestrians from under the pedestrian bridge to the Cottons Centre to Bermondsey Street. The footpath on the other side of the road will remain open throughout the closure.

Cyclists

Cyclists will be able to travel in both directions on Tooley Street - westbound with the traffic and eastbound in a segregated lane.

Taxis

The taxi rank on Tooley Street moves to Bermondsey Street and remains there once the new station is completed.

Buses

Throughout the Tooley Street works, TfL bus routes 47, 343, 381, N199 and RV1 will be diverted. All westbound bus services will operate as normal, and access to and from the bus station at London Bridge station will be retained as normal.
