Plan ahead

There will be no Southeastern trains to or from Charing Cross, Waterloo East and London Bridge from Saturday 26 August to Saturday 2 September, including four working days.

There will be fewer trains into London, they will be diverted to alternative stations and they will be extremely busy. Some stations will have queueing systems in place. Your ticket will be accepted on alternative routes.

Start considering your plan B:

Travel outside of peak times, work from home (if possible) or use alternative routes.

What it means for you

The Thameslink Programme is part of the Railway Upgrade Plan which helps meet the massive rise in demand for train services as well as reducing delays and improving connections. It will also ease congestion on the London Underground.

When our improvement work is complete in 2018, passengers will benefit from:

- A new London Bridge station with more space and better facilities
- More reliable, more frequent journeys when Thameslink trains will run every 2 to 3 minutes through central London at the busiest times (St Pancras International to Blackfriars)
- Improved connections giving better travel options to more destinations north and south of London
- New track and modern trains for more reliable journeys
- A brand-new rail hub at Farringdon, connecting Thameslink with Elizabeth line (Crossrail) services, offering direct links to three major international airports and St Pancras International

What's happening?

August and September 2017

There will be closures and changes to Southeastern, Southern and Thameslink services in 2017 as the Thameslink Programme continues to rebuild London Bridge station and the surrounding railway.

No Southeastern trains to or from **Charing Cross**, **Waterloo East** and **London Bridge** for eight days. Trains will go to alternative London stations. This includes four working days.

No Southeastern trains to or from **Cannon Street** on Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 August.

Reduced Southern service to or from **London Bridge** on Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 August.
